Lizz Wright draws inspiration from her Southern upbringing in Georgia, where she was the music director of a small church where her father was the pastor. Soon she would traverse the Great American Songbook on her path. At the age of 22, she first made a name for herself nationally as a vocalist with a touring concert tribute to Billie Holiday. At 23, she signed with Verve Records for the 2003 release of her debut album, «Salt», which topped *Billboard's* contemporary jazz charts. She went on to record for Universal Music and released the albums «Dreaming Wide Awake» (2005), «The Orchard» (2008) and «Fellowship» (2010). On the Concord label, she released «Freedom & Surrender» (2016) and «Grace» (2017). Lizz Wright launched her own independent record company, Blues & Greens Records, with the 2022 release of the live album «Holding Space». The label creates a healthy ecosystem for her, with sustainable and sound business practices at the forefront. Earlier this year, she released her studio debut album, «Shadow». She penned its five original songs celebrating the intimacy of romantic love, loss, community, and healing. The disc also features artists Angélique Kidjo and Meshell Ndegeocello. Lizz Wright last performed at the Philharmonie Luxembourg during the 2005/06 season.
