### The renting fee includes

- Use of the GA and the pertaining back-stage area. All activity in the GA and in the back-stage area must be finished by 11:00 pm. To keep to this schedule, we suggest ending any concert/event by 10:30 pm at latest.
- 1 stage manager. Stage handling work, including basic lighting, must be managed by the Public Establishment.
- 1 Public Establishment representative.
- Standard cleaning service.

#### Mandatory Services2)

- Min. 22 people provided by the Public Establishment to assist visitors and 1 person for the cloakroom:
  - 34 €/pers/hour (business days)
  - 60 €/pers/hour (Sundays)
  - o 67 €/pers/hour (national holidays)

The number of people and the duration of the visitor support and cloakroom service vary with the type of event and the audience size. They are at the discretion of the Public Establishment.
