

Grand Auditorium (GA) Rental Terms and Conditions

Description of the GA

Facility

Maximum capacity: 1,471 seats1)

Maximum capacity for amplified concert: 1,214 seats¹⁾ Seating layout:

- orchestra: 90 seats
- stalls: 730 seats
- tower seats: 95 + 6 extra seats for disabled persons (in wheelchairs)
- balcony: 168 seats
- 6 towers with 28 seats and 2 towers with 22 seats (premium tours)
- organ seats: 32 seats
- choir: 144 seats

Stage

Surface area: 170–280 sq. m, consisting of 21 mobile platforms. Dimensions (length x width): 19 m x 15 m. Technical equipment: basic equipment.

Grand Foyer

Surface area: 2,700 sq. m

Catering: cf. terms and conditions governing catering service organisation.

Renting fee²⁾

Basic price for amplified / commercial concert: 14.175 $\in^{3^{3/4}}$ (max. 14 hours of use)

Reduced price for non-amplified / non-commercial concert:

7.900 €3)4) (max. 7 hours of use)

Price for a conference: 9.345 €³⁾⁴⁾ (max. 10 hours of use)

The renting fee includes:

- Use of the GA and the pertaining back-stage area. All activity in the GA and in the back-stage area must be finished by 11:00pm. To keep to this schedule, we suggest ending any concert/event by 10:30pm at latest.
- 1 stage manager. Stage handling work, including basic lighting, must be managed by the Public Establishment.
- 1 Public Establishment representative.
- Standard cleaning service.

Mandatory Services²⁾

- At least 22 people provided by the Public Establishment to assist visitors and 1 person for the cloakroom:
 - o 35 €/pers/hour (business days)
 - o 63 €/pers/hour (Sundays)
 - o 70 €/pers/hour (national holidays)

The number of people and the duration of the visitor support and cloakroom service vary with the type of event and the audience size. They are at the discretion of the Public Establishment.
